- A 40-year collection of hand fans, a world-class archive. Includes thousands of fans and related objects, paintings, miniatures etc., Collection not only from India but also China, Japan, Egypt, Africa and South East Asia. The collection has been exhibited at National and International museums in India and overseas, such as the National Crafts Museum Delhi, The Victoria Memorial Kolkata; Fan Museum London; Reitzberg Museum Zurich; National Art Gallery, Kuala Lumpur; National Museum Manila; and the Kennedy Centre, Washington DC USA, Indira Gandhi National Centre for the Arts (IGNCA), New Delhi. There is a proposal to house the entire collection in the National Pankha Museum in New Delhi. A book on the subject, 'To Stir the Still Air', was published by Sahitya Akademi Delhi in 2022. The Department of Post, Philately has brought out 15 postal stamps on Pankha.
